- Debra Segiet has been working on ways to showcase Project Lead the Way classes; she will be presenting in front of the board; we would like to showcase the student's work and highlight those classes
- We might have the head of the state veterans affairs at the assembly (Peter also invited Obama, George W. Bush)

Principal's Report (Gina Reeder)

- Parent Teacher Conferences (PTCs) Thanks for lunch and dinner during PTCs; There were team meetings today and everyone said PTCs went very well; Over 80% of PTC timeslots were filled (about same as last year; we made a big jump last year and maintained it); for parents that don't speak English, there were about 12 bi-lingual teachers and support staff.
