

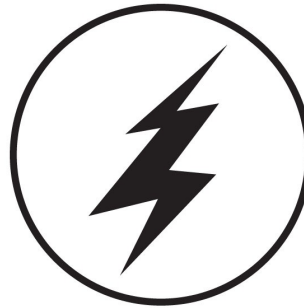
How Positive Family Support links with PBIS (Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports)



Our PBIS team has defined what **safe, respectful, and responsible behaviors** are expected in all common areas of our school. All students are expected to follow our “3 BE’s”.

When students are seen following our schoolwide expectations, they can be rewarded with a “ticket”.

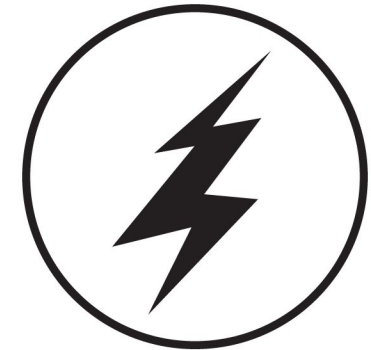

The goals of the Positive Family Support Program are....

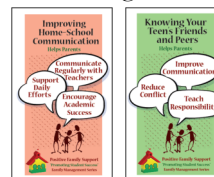
- to help families be more aware of the school's expectations for positive behavior,

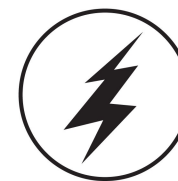
